# First experience with Comenius-project



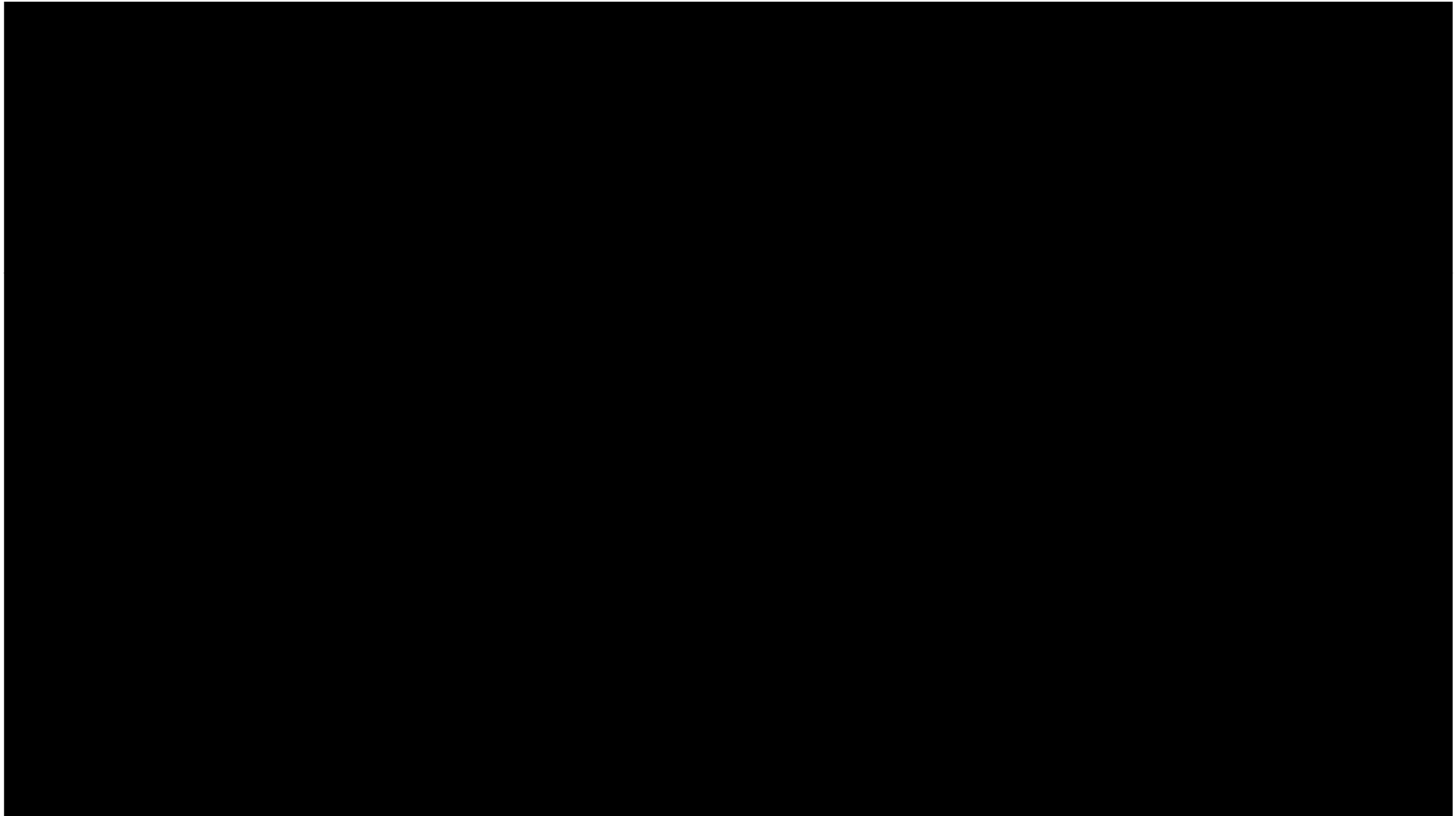
- First official European project for us. We started out with great enthusiasm.

# What did we experience the first time?

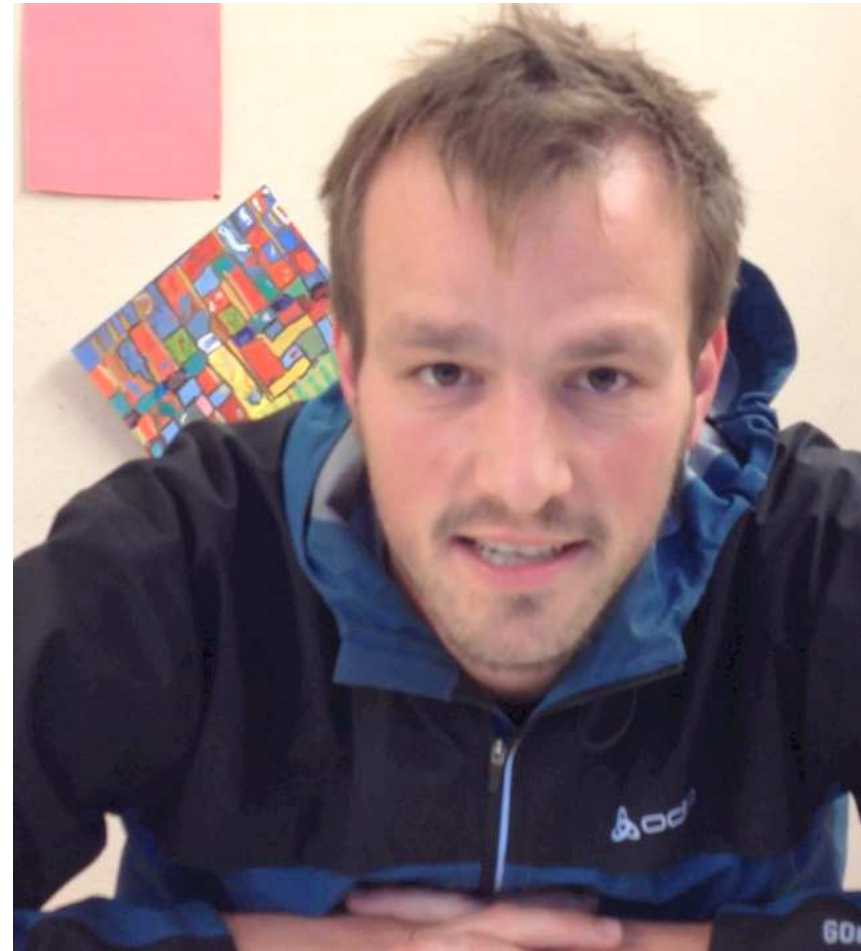
- Teachers were asked lots of extra questions = very positive but tough for non-economists.

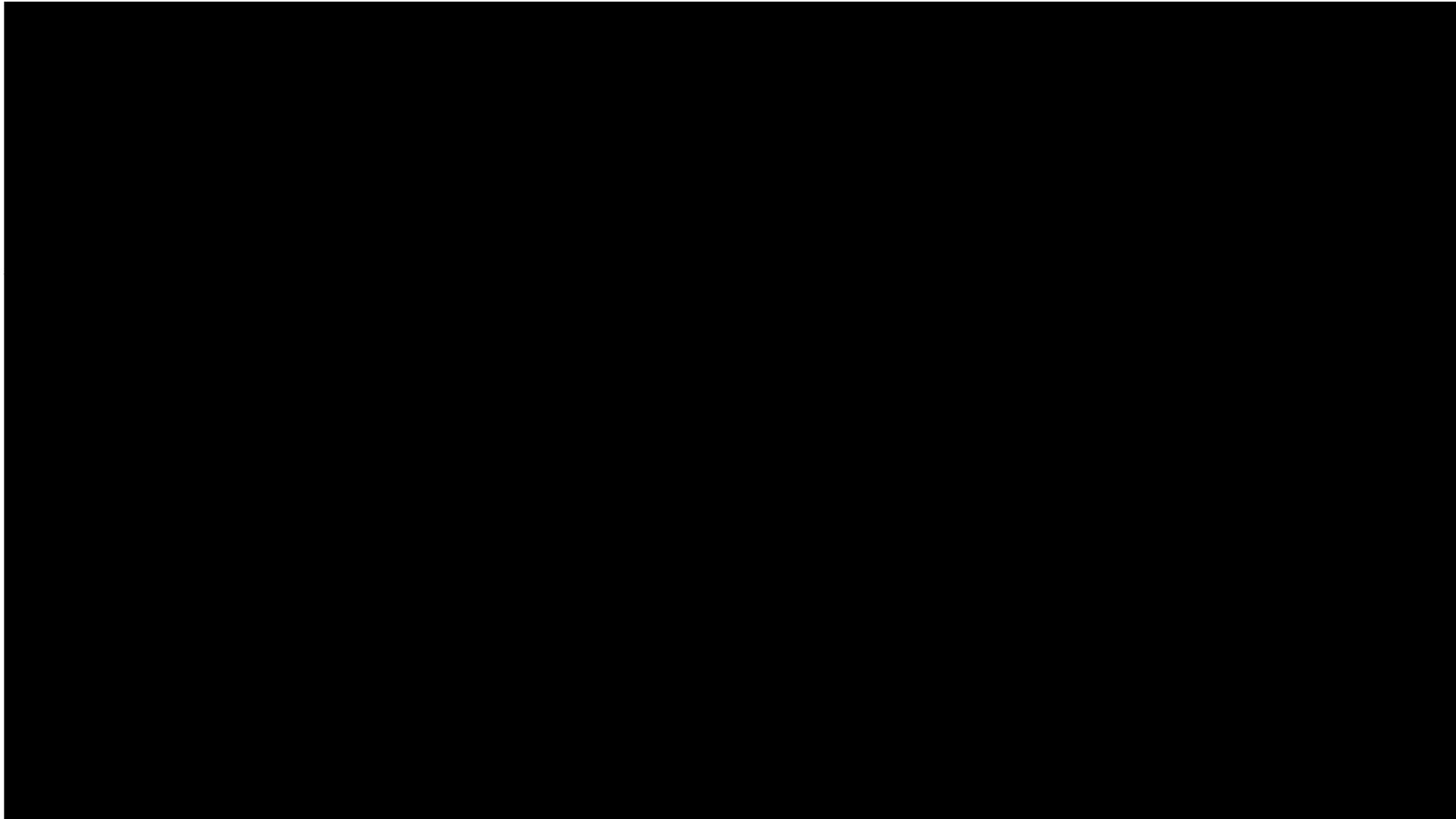

*\*The Questionnaire was presented only 5 months after the course.*

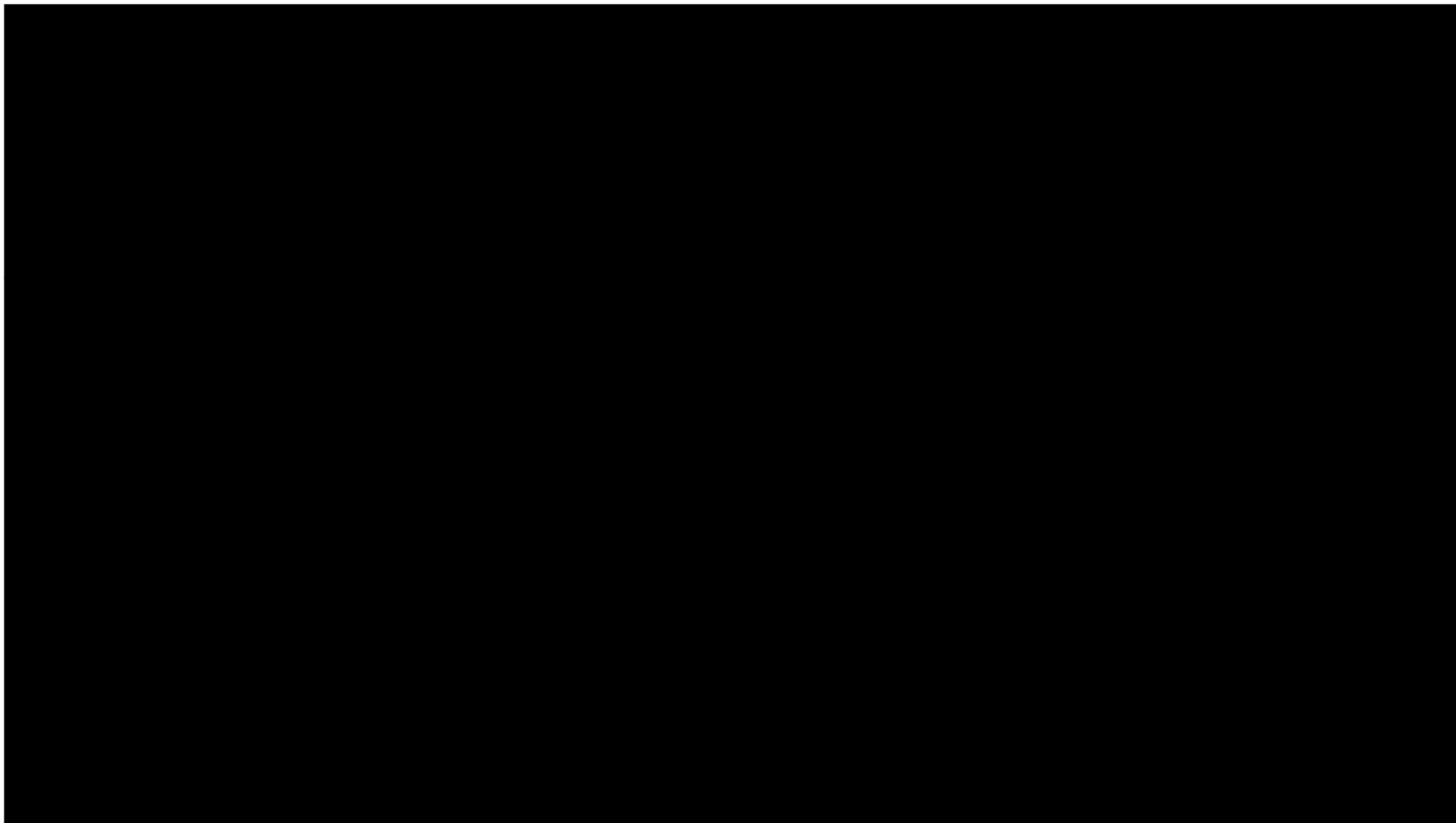
