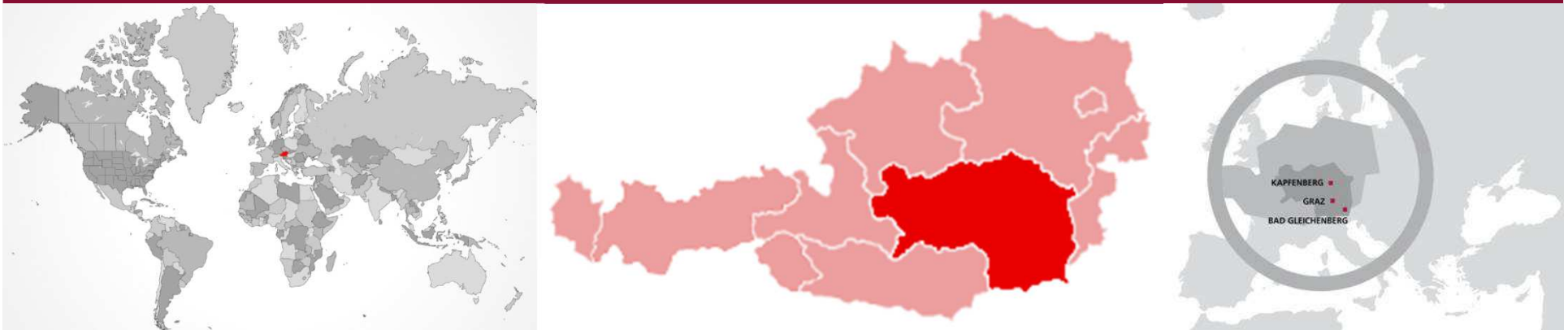

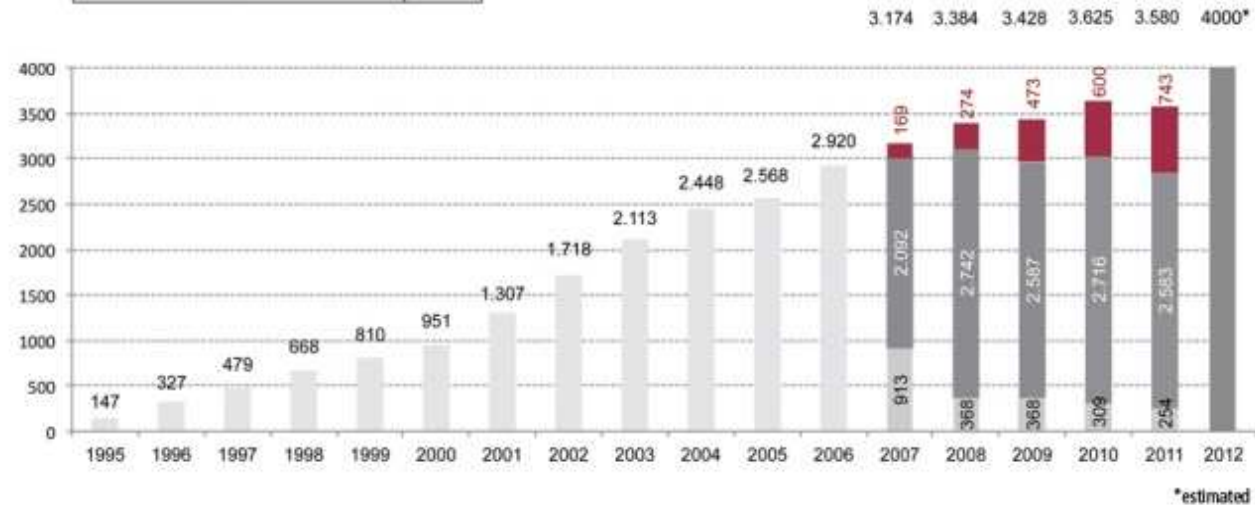

FH JOANNEUM started with 4 degree programmes in Graz and Kapfenberg as Technikum Joanneum GmbH
- 2001
The third campus was opened
- 2003
The first Bachelor programme started, the change to the Bologna system began
- 2007
FH JOANNEUM got the legal status of a University of Applied Sciences
- 2012
40 degree programmes, ~4000 students, 3 campuses, 46% women
